The agenda of the meeting is to analyze the activities of IQAC for the session 2020-2021. The activities which are analyzed during the meeting are as follows:

- After the completion of admission process, an Online Induction Programme was organized on 26.12.2020 for students of first year in which various activities were analyzed under Higher Education Department, Vikram University, Schemes of Madhya Pradesh Government, Scholarships, Student Tracking, Remedial classes, Student Satisfaction Survey, Cultural Activities, Youth festival, Swami Vivekananda Career Guidance Cell, NSS, NCC, Sports Facilities, & Government Arts and Science College Ratlam.
- Remedial classes were conducted from 21.02.2021 to 27.03.2021 for slow learner students of UG level in which 303 students took the advantage. Whereas advanced learner students took the advantage of e-content, videos, webinars, & expert lectures.
- Under the guidance of IQAC International Webinar on Recent Trends in Mathematics (06.08.2020 & 07.08.2020), Virtual Conference on NEP (05.09.2020), National Webinar

on Recent Trends in Application of Spectroscopy (28.01.2021 to 30.01.2021), & Expert Lecture on Economics (24.02.2021) were successfully organized.

- Under the umbrella of IQAC Webinar was organized on women empowerment in science under the title "Role of Women in Science."
- Upgradation of the infrastructure construction of new teaching rooms and renovation of office building started.
- Leveling work of sports ground executed.
- New devices had been purchased in order to upgrade laboratories.
- Training programme for students was conducted between 08.02.2021-09.03.2021 to improve ICT skills and language & communication.
- One day training programme was organized regarding Life-Skills under "Be with Yoga be at Home" and "Importance of Yoga and Pranayama."
- Under Covid-19 awareness programme, "Yuva Shakti Corona Mukti Abhiyaan" was organized from 19.06.2021 to 11.08.2021 in which training of Corona Appropriate Behavior was provided to 1660 students.
- Masks and sanitizers were distributed to students under the activities of Eco-Club of the college.
- Apart from conventional methods of teaching for various classes, blended, hybrid, & flipped methods were also incorporated.
- Assessment of result analysis had been taken place.
- Various modes of CCE for students were incorporated in which online mode of CCE was applied to those subjects which have large number of students.
- Teaching planner analyzed and it is observed that teachers followed the same while teaching.
