The following decisions were taken unanimously in the meeting:

- An Induction programme is to be organized for the newly admitted students of B.A. and B.Sc. First and Second years. In the programme students should be given introduction of the college along with the information of different scholarship schemes of government and different activities organized at the college.
- 2. Students should be included in the Whats App groups made on the basis of subjects and classrooms to ensure their receiving the academic information and notices from the college. This will ease the sharing of study material as well.

- 3. Feedback of students, alumni, teachers and employers should be obtained in the session, analysed and Action-Taken Report should be made.
- 4. A meeting should be called for the department heads to discuss the project works of UG I and II year and Open Elective and Vocational subjects in UG II year keeping NEP 2020 in view. The project work of PG IV Semester should also be discussed in the same meeting.
- 5. All the certificate courses conducted in the previous session should be continued in the present session and possibility of new Add on courses should be considered.
- 6. Students should be encouraged to register themselves in SWAYAM NPTEL Courses.
- 7. Teachers should be encouraged to integrate blended mode of teaching in classrooms.
- 8. The Course Outcome of UG II year should be prepared according to NEP 2020. Levels of Bloom's Taxonomy are to be incorporated while preparing curse outcomes.
- 9. Attainment of Course outcomes and Programme outcomes should be evaluated.
- 10. An award function for academic excellence and achievements based on the result analysis should be organized.
- 11. Different modes should be used for CCE of UG III year and PG I, II, III and IV Sem.
- 12. CCE of UG I and II should be conducted according to the guideline of NEP 2020.
- 13. Models, films, posters and other effective means should be incorporated into teaching with increasing involvement of the students.
- 14. Department heads should be directed to point out slow and advance learners of respective subjects and create a action plan accordingly.
- 15. All departments should design a work-plan for academic excellence through the activities like Expert lectures, Seminar/Webinar/Conference, Industrial Tour, workshops on IPR and Research Methodology, FDP/SDP and Activities related to Skill-development etc. with the support of the funds received from WB/MPHEQIP and prepare work plan of outreach activities.
- 16. The Research Policy of the institution should be reviewed. The Research Advisory Cell should encourage research activities by providing seed-money to students and faculty.
- 17. N- list subscription for E- resources should be continued
- 18. MOUs should be signed with local industries and educational institutions to strengthen the bond with these organisations.

- 19. Arts and Science Faculty would organise one exhibition each to encourage the creative thrust of the students. IQAC initiated to develop an "Idea House" to encourage students and faculty for innovative activities.
- 20. The present arrangement of the library facility should be improved and better managed till the construction of new building for it.
- 21. An open gym should be established with the financial support from RUSA.
- 22. Classes should be conducted in the new block of the campus.
- 23. Labs should be upgraded as per requirement.
- 24. Internet facility should be upgraded.
- 25. Free preparatory classes for competitive exams should be initiated for aspirants and Career fair should be organized.
- 26. Local culture should be encouraged in the cultural and youth activities through use of folk art and music.
- 27. Student-members should be involved in various committees of the college and their participation should be ensured.
- 28. Health camps should be organized to create awareness towards good health and wellbeing 29. Sports activities should be organized along with the maintenance of all the sports related places on the campus.
- 30. Various programmes should be organized to celebrate 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsava'.
- 31. Programmes to inculcate awareness towards water conservation and energy conservation should be organised.

- 3. Different modes should be used for UG III year (B.A./B.Sc.) and PG (all the four semesters).
- 4. Question papers for CCE should be prepared keeping the learning outcome in view.
- 5. The time table of the CCE for UG should be declared at least one week before the date of commencement of the assessment.
- 6. Department heads should decide and release the CCE time table for PG.
- 7. According to NEP2020 every student of UG I and II year is supposed to
- i) Select one of Field project/ Internship / apprenticeship or Community Engagement;
- ii) Submit three progress reports from which two best will be considered for internal assessment of 50 marks.
- 8. Teachers should be directed to guide and help the students under their supervision to choose the project work as per the guideline of NEP2020
- 9. Concerned teacher of PG project work should help students choose their topic with local needs, employment and pro-research and related to their PG subject as well.
- 10. The external assessment of the above project work will be done for 50 marks by the examiner elected by the university.

Action Taken Report Academic Year 2022-23

- The AQAR for the session 2021-22 was submitted on 02.05.2023 by IQAC.
- An Induction programme was organised for the newly admitted students in the first year of graduation to impart information regarding NEP-2020, various scholarships, schemes and activities conducted in the college.
- WhatsApp groups were created for each class to share Study material (in Hindi and English), video lectures, and important information among students implementing Hybrid mode of teachinglearning.
- NEP-2020 syllabus was implemented in UG I and II year. Teaching work was also reviewed as per the teaching planners submitted by the corresponding faculty.
- UG II year course outcomes were amended according to NEP-2020 and needed changes were made in the remaining courses as required. IQAC finalized the Learning outcomes.
- Curriculum based online feedback was collected from outgoing students, teachers, alumni and employers. Feedback analysis was done by IQAC and accordingly an action taken report was prepared.
- IQAC made best efforts for paperless documentation.
- The departments organized an Entry level test to select slow and advanced learners to imply extra efforts made for them accordingly.
- Open elective courses were continued in UG II year in accordance of the selected courses of UG I
 year to execute the concept of interdisciplinary/multidisciplinary courses of NEP-2020.
- Vocational courses, especially, Organic Farming, Vermicomposting, Food Preservation and Processing, Digital Marketing, Medical Diagnostics, Personality Development, Electronic Technology, and Web-designing were provided to students of Arts and Science faculty for skill development with facility of choosing one of them.
- To lay emphasis on Women-Empowerment Judo-Karate training and Self-defence camp was organized from 26.09.2022 to 01.10.2022. In continuation of the same purpose National Girl Child Day was celebrated on 24.01.2023. The department of Social Science and M.S.W. organized a programme of Legal-awareness with special reference to women to add to the objective.
- The CCE of UG I and II year of all the departments were conducted according to the guidelines of NEP2020 while CCE of UG III year and PG I, II, III, IV were conducted in different modes.

- Under the auspices of IQAC with the funds provided by WB/MPHEQIP National and International Conferences were organized by different departments on 'Sustainable Development, Environment, Agriculture and Life-Sciences', 'Current Developments in Mathematical Sciences and E-Learning', 'Women Empowerment and Sustainable Development' in online, offline and hybrid modes. Several Educational and Industrial Tours were organized during the session to different places enriching the experience of the students and the faculty in specific subject and area of interest. A workshop on Hindi was organized followed by a district level workshop on Entrepreneurship, Sustainability and Rural Engagement in collaboration of IQAC and MGNCRE, Hyderabad, also on 'Intellectual Property Rights' a workshop of two days was organized.
- Revered Padmashri Dr. Leela Joshi was invited to deliver lecture on 'Health: Yesterday, Today and Tomorrow' in the series of Expert lectures of various fields organised by different departments through the year.
- An initiative of organizing a health camp created awareness in the students and teachers.
- The special days i.e. Teachers' Day, World Rabies Day, World AIDS Day, International Day of Education, National Girl Child Day, Darwin Day, National Science Day, Women's Day, Indian Languages' Day, Wet-Land Day, Hindi-Diwas, International Tiger Day, Hippo Day, Mathematics Day, National Sports Day, Science Day, Homeopathy Day, World Wild-Life Day were celebrated and activities were conducted according to the occasion.
- IQAC initiative "Idea House" inspired some activities that are unique in nature and valuable in practice.
- One exhibition by Science and Arts Faculty each was organized to encourage creativity by presenting models, charts, flow charts, paintings and posters prepared by students.
- 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsava' was celebrated through various programmes during the session.
- Free training and coaching classes for preparation of competitive exams were arranged by Vivekananda Career Guidance Cell along with the special lectures on Career and job opportunities by Experts. A Career fair was also organized.
- Atm Nirbhar Madhya Pradesh on Short Term Employment and Self-Employment, the online programmes was introduced to the Students.
- NCC and NSS units of the Institute organized significant activities throughout the session. Different departments conducted many outreach activities.

- Classroom teaching was commenced in the rooms of the new building constructed with the approval of the HE department and the amount of Rs.3.53/- received from RUSA.
- The Lab Apparatus were purchased by Physics department with the grant of Rs.2,15,000/- from RUSA.
- The current interret facilities were improved and improvised with the establishment of a Leased Line.
- In three different buildings of the college the Vending-Machines for sanitary use for girls were installed.
